#### ADDITION - BERKELEY, CA

Roth/LaMotte Landscape Architecture worked in conjunction with Operation Architecture to design an addition and garden renovation for a residence in the Berkeley hills. The garden design is a partial renovation and update from a design by Lawrence Halprin. With spectacular views to the bay and Tilden Park, the project emphasizes native plantings, rainwater catchment and de-synchronization - celebrating process while utilizing some of the original design concepts from Mr. Halprin.

The water feature re-circulates rainwater through a fountain that negotiates both built forms and the original more natural forms.

SLEEPY HOLLOW SWIMMING POOL - 2002 Project design, management and construction observation by Roth/LaMotte for new back-yard with swimming pool and patio. The project transformed a little used, narrow yard into an important outdoor room for the house by enhancing the relationship of the interior space to the pool garden.

ROB HILL CAMPGROUND- THE PRESIDIO TRUST - SAN FRANCISCO, CA. - 2008-2010 Project Design for site amenities and visitor use for the only public campground within San Francisco. Project included the design of four group camping areas, building pad areas for gathering, amphitheater and fire pit as well as site paving, walls, custom furnishings and signs. Project design highlights universal access as well as the use of locally harvested materials for custom site furnishings.









### LUCAS VALLEY OFFICE BUILDING - SAN RAFAEL, CA. - 1998

Project planting design and land management design by Roth/LaMotte for an aging commercial office building landscape. The design features locally native plantings to replace diseased and inappropriate ornamentals. Project has successfully revegetated a large island in a parking lot at the entrance to the office building, utilizing Caliornia Fescue, Valley Oak and the protection of existing seedings of Live Oak and Bay Laurel to extend the woodland setting into the existing parking island.






Plan Rendering - early concept


### MORI POINT BOARDWALK, PACIFICA, CA 2007-2009

This project focused on the design of an elevated boardwalk that will both allow visitors to cross sensitive coastal habitat and for the survival of endangered fauna. The alignment and elevation of the boardwalk was coordinated with recently constructed ponds and spillways as well as historic road alignment.

Materials and construction methods and sequencing were carefully coordinated with the Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy to ensure best practices would be implemented. This project was completed in the Fall of x2009.
















HAWK HILL, MARIN HEADLANDS Overlooking the Golden Gate, Hawk Hill is a popular destination for tourists, hikers, and bird watching enthusiasts. The objective of this project was to improve accessibility while respecting the natural and historical context of the site. All planning and design efforts were done in conjunction with major restoration and road improvement projects along with input from the Golden Gate National Parks Conservancey and various user groups. # LARKSPUR LANDING SHOPPING CENTER, LARKSPUR, CA

Working in conjunction with the offices of Lawerence Halprin and Smith+Smith, a master plan was developed with the aim of rejuvenating the Larkspur Landing shopping center. The plan intended to create vibrant spaces within the center for visitors and also provided key connections to the adjacent neighborhood and to the Larkspur Ferry Terminal. The schematic design also included exploration and presentation of hardscape and plant materials selections.

### ROSS GARDEN - ROSS, CA

This project began with the need to replace a dark, depressing fence and retaining wall. The final design replaced those with a sense of permanence that also made them places that beckoned one to engage in the outdoors. The hardwood fences and gates invite one to slide your hand aloong the edges of the garden, while the stone fireplace and barbeque make the narrow backyard a precious place for entertaining that is at once inviting and comforting as the attention to the details and needs of everyday life unfold along the space.

### WEST MARIN RESIDENCE

Designed and implemented by Roth/LaMotte for a residential garden. Project included design of a kitchen garden, multi use courtyard and connecting in-law unit to main house. Differentiation of passage versus respite is accomplished through shifts in paving, while the fencing details reflect on the nearby ranchlands in a refined manner.
